The Waterfront Assistant works under the Waterfront Director to ensure camper safety during all waterfront activities on Bills Lake, assist with swim instruction, and support water-based programming including swimming, canoeing, and water games.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide vigilant supervision during all waterfront activities
- Respond to aquatic emergencies
- Assist with swim tests and swimming lessons
- Help maintain waterfront equipment, boats, and facilities
- Support waterfront programming (canoeing, boating, water games, etc.)
- Enforce safety rules and procedures
- Assist Waterfront Director with daily operations
- Maintain a positive, safety-focused attitude

Required Qualifications:

- Minimum 17 years of age
- Strong swimming skills
- Camp or aquatic facility experience preferred
- Responsible, alert, and safety-conscious
- Ability to work as part of a team
- Must pass background check
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs and work on your feet
